

FRANCE - The Original Tour





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PARIS TO THE COTE D'AZUR - AND BACK.

This very special 21 day tour has been developed in response to requests from our clients. We have included substantial stays in the most well known areas of France.

In **PARIS**, we spend almost a week in the **Marais district (3rd / 4th arrondissement)**. Then, a fast train to **NICE** and 5 days there with trips to the surrounding areas of the **Cote d'Azur**. Train again to **Provence**, where we stay in **AVIGNON** for 5 nights. On then, to our favourite chateau hotel in the **LOIRE VALLEY**. Finally, return to Paris for the opening of **Monet's** garden at **Giverny** – a perfect end to our tour.

WE ARE DIFFERENT!

Our <u>hotels</u> are always boutique style. We choose them to be in the centre, so that we are relaxing with a coffee when the tourist buses are leaving. We also choose them for their uniqueness. Our PARIS hotel has been chosen for its place in the Marais district, close to the bohemian sector and the city centre. The hotel in NICE is close to the sea and has a beautiful garden. AVIGNON'S hotel choice is an ancient cloister and monastery in the medieval town. Chateau de Beauvois Hotel in the LOIRE, is a privately owned, historic chateau.

We *never* have early starts or one night stays. Emphasis is always on relaxation and great experiences.

The <u>experiences</u> we offer cater to all tastes. There are always opportunities for a quiet sit with a coffee or cocktail – and time to do your own thing too.

Our *Experiences List* includes: Making your own perfume in Grasse, markets of many types, an evening tour of the Louvre, wine tasting in the Loire, walk the glorious Rothschild Gardens near Nice, inside Monaco's Casino, artisans in St Remy, lavender farm in Provence, a concert in the Sainte Chapelle Paris, following the Van Gogh trail in Provence, Chateau visits in the Loire Valley – and a mushroom farm inside a hill! Of course – Monet's garden at Giverny.

We have <u>women guides</u> at each stop. These women, along with their Art History qualifications, have unqualified passion for their regions.

All museum <u>entrances</u> are designed to avoid queues. We visit 'must see' places as well as special spots 'off the beaten track'.

<u>Travel</u> is by TGV fast train between each stay. We have First Class seats. Within each area, we travel by minibus or taxi or we walk. In Paris, we use both the metro and taxis.

<u>Two meals</u> are included each day. You can expect them to be breakfast and dinner unless notified otherwise. We dine in a mix of restaurants, cafes, home-style and silver service.

INCLUSIVE.

What this means is:

- All transfers, tips etc
- First class train travel
- Your own double room, single use
- No single supplement
- Two meals each day
- Private transport in country eg: mini bus, taxi,
- All entrances
- Private guides
- Private events eg: perfume making, wine tasting, artisan visits, concerts, specialist talks, private villa/garden visits...

- Your own tailored photo album of the tour.

Day 2 - Sunday -	Arrive Paris: (most will arrive around 1.30pm- est. arrival time at hotel = 3pm)
22 September Hotel Croix de la Bretonnerie (5 +2 nights)	
	Meet in the hotel lobby and assist with check-in.
	We will wander around our area - Afternoon tea on Place de Vosges
	Back to the hotel for a break.
	Early Dinner nearby
Day 3 – Monday – 23 September	We begin our day with a walk across to <i>Notre Dame Cathedral</i> on the Ile de la Cite (Isle of the City in the River, at the end of our street) ** Map of our area at end of this itinerary
	There we will meet our guide and take a walking tour of the <i>Left Bank</i> – <i>historic, infamous sights</i>
	Taxis to Coffee/lunch on the top floor of <i>Galleries Lafayette</i>
	Then we can tour the <i>Opera Garnier</i> - OR - you may like to spend some time in the very glamorous shops of the area.
	Return to the hotel – time at leisure
	Dinner this evening in the Marais at Le Connetable.
Day 4 – Tuesday – 24 September	Take our own minibus to <i>Versailles</i> . Tour at your own speed, with our own whispers guides
	Catch the mini train for lunch at <i>La Flotille</i> in the palace gardens
	Return to Paris and our hotel.
	Dinner in the <i>Pigalle</i> area for all.
	** Optional Supper Show: Moulin Rouge at 9.00pm

Day 5 Wednesday - 24 September	This morning we have a 'no queue' entry to the <i>Musee d'Orsay</i> . Once a railway station, now home to the Impressionists
	Meet in the D'Orsay Restaurant for lunch.
	At 5pm we meet for an early evening visit to <i>The Louvre</i> with our guide Oriel
	After the visit – coffee, a light meal nearby.
Day 6 Thursday 25 September	We join our local guide for a visit to the artists of <i>Montmartre</i> and the <i>Sacré Coeur cathedral</i> on this famous hilltop. Time to see the <i>Salvadore Dali's</i> unusual art work too.
	Lunch/coffee together in Montmartre
	Afternoon free
	Evening candle-light concert at magnificent Sainte Chapelle
	Dinner to follow, on the island – Ile de la Cite'
Day 7 Friday –	The Cote D'Azur
26 September	<u>First class TGV to <i>Nice</i> on the French Riviera –</u> we leave at 9am and arrive at 3pm. Lunch on the train as we cross France. Jean Jacques will be there to
Hotel Villa Victoria	collect us.
(4 nights)	Wander along the sea to the Nice old town to get to know our area. A drink on the promenade in the sun
	Dinner at <i>Maison Marie</i>
Day 8 Saturday - 27 September	Walking tour of Old Nice with Agnes - including a visit to the famous flower markets and little specialist shops. Maybe an art gallery - or two!
27 September	Little train around Nice Port and view from the top of the cliffs
	Meet in the hotel bar for a cocktail
	Walk to Dinner at <i>Le Vingt 4</i> – near our hotel
Day 9 Sunday -	Cote d'Azur with Agnes - first stop - magnificent Villa Ephrussi de Rothschild
28 September	On to <i>Monte Carlo</i> in the Principality of <i>Monaco</i>
	Afternoon tea and a look around at the Monte Carlo <i>Casino</i>
	Return to Hotel Villa Victoria
	Dinner on the harbor in Nice – <i>La Vigna</i>

Day 10 Monday - 29 September	Visit to the old 'perched village' of <i>Gourdon</i> - a country drive to the village, magnificent views, unique crafts, shops and cafes. On to <i>Grasse</i> to make our own perfume at <i>Galimard</i> 1747, <i>perfumier:</i> 2pm. Return to Nice at 4pm. Free time Dinner in Nice TBA
Day 11 Tuesday -	Avignon and Provence
30 September	TGV Train trip 3.5hrs takes us to Avignon, arriving at 1.30pm
Hotel Cloitre St	Check in and explore this former cloister now hotel.
Louis	Introduction to Avignon's medieval town -within the town walls.
(4 nights)	Dinner at Cour de Louvre Restaurant
Day 12 Wednesday - 1	Around Provence by mini bus with Laurence
October	We follow the <i>Van Gogh</i> trail to the places he lived and painted
	St Remy de Provence – this is Market Day!
	Les Baux de Provence, a medieval village - home to the amazing Carrières de Lumières set in an abandoned quarry!
	Return to our hotel for Dinner.
Day 13 Thursday – 2 October	The <i>Luberon</i> region with LaurenceDrive through <i>L'Isle sur la Sorgue</i> , to the spectacular village of <i>Gordes</i> , continue to <i>Roussillon</i> with its red and orange cliffs & then the Lavender museum.
	Lunch along the way – and <i>Wine</i> -tasting at <i>Menerbes</i>
	Dinner overlooking the <i>Palace of the Popes</i>
Day 14 Friday -	Morning of medieval Avignon and the <i>Popes' Palace</i> with Laurence
3 October	Lunch overlooking the medieval palace. We stroll out onto the "Pont d'Avignon"
	Afternoon at leisure for shopping, packing, other museums
	Dinner in an historic restaurant near old the water wheels.

Day 15 Saturday -	Loire Valley
4 October	TGV to Tours - Loire Valley
Château de Beauvois (4 nights)	The bus takes us to the magnificent Chateau de Beauvois (16 th Century) where we are welcomed by our hosts with a glass of champagne in the salon.
	Explore the Chateau and its chapel, cellars and grounds
	Dine this evening in the Chateau
Day 16 Sunday - 5 October	Out and About in the <i>Loire Valley</i>
	We drive to the Royal castle town of <i>Amboise</i> Time to spend in the <i>weekly town market</i> along the River Loire. Stalls, tastings, music etc
	Lunch / coffee at <i>Bigot</i> (chocolate maker -fabulous!)
	Visit the mighty castle and then on to <i>Clos Luce</i> , home of <i>Leonardo da Vinci</i> (see many of his inventions at work)
	Dinner in our Chateau
Day 17 Monday -	Tour today a wonderful pair of Chateaux
6 October	Visit <i>Villandry</i> - the most famous gardens in the Loire et Cher region
	On to <i>Chenonceau</i> the magnificent chateau of the two women –
	Light lunch together in the Orangerie - Afternoon free
	Dinner in the Chateau
Day 18 Tuesday – 7 October	Suit yourself today – talk with PK about some options
Day 19 Wednesday - 8	Loire to Paris
October	Leisurely start to the day at the chateau Farewell picture on the steps
Hotel Croix de la	Return by TGV to Paris (55mins). Taxis to Hotel
Bretonnerie	Afternoon free OR come with Penny to the <i>Carnavalet</i> Museum
	Dinner at the oldest café in Paris – <i>Le Procope</i>
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Day 20 Thursday- 9 October	Private mini bus takes us to the little town of <i>Giverny</i> , west of Paris. We visit the gardens of the Impressionist painter <i>Monet</i> . Lunch – A delightful visit for lovers of the Impressionists. The restaurant where Renoir painted <i>'Luncheon of the Boating Party'</i> . Free time. Dinner on the <i>Eiffel Tower</i> at 9pm
Day 21 Friday – 10 October	Breakfast together in the old wine cellar Transfers for the Airport We leave Paris for home *** This Itinerary may be subject to change
